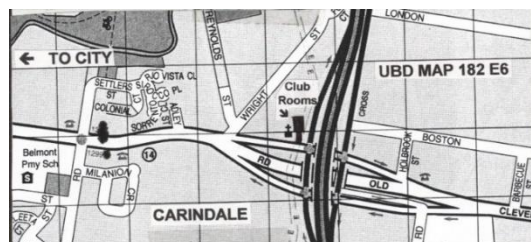
PARKING AT CLUBROOMS
